Dear Parent/Carer

I write to you today as we head towards the end of session in relation to school uniform. To clarify, Mearns Academy uniform is as detailed below.

### **The Mearns Academy Uniform**

**Uniform is:** white shirt, school tie, black plain jersey or cardigan, school trousers or skirt, black or brown shoes, or black trainers with no colour/white. There is an expectation that Blazers are worn. Blazers are compulsory for prefects.

**Uniform should be worn:** with ties at or near the neck with non-fitted shirts tucked in trousers/skirt.

**In-Class:** all outside jackets/hooded tops/non-school clothing should be removed.

To support with uniform, we have arranged for Logoxpres to come into school on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June to measure and to fit all pupils for a blazer. They provide an online service for the provision of uniform and information will be shared with parents. The approximate cost of a blazer is £30.
