# Citizenship - Course Content

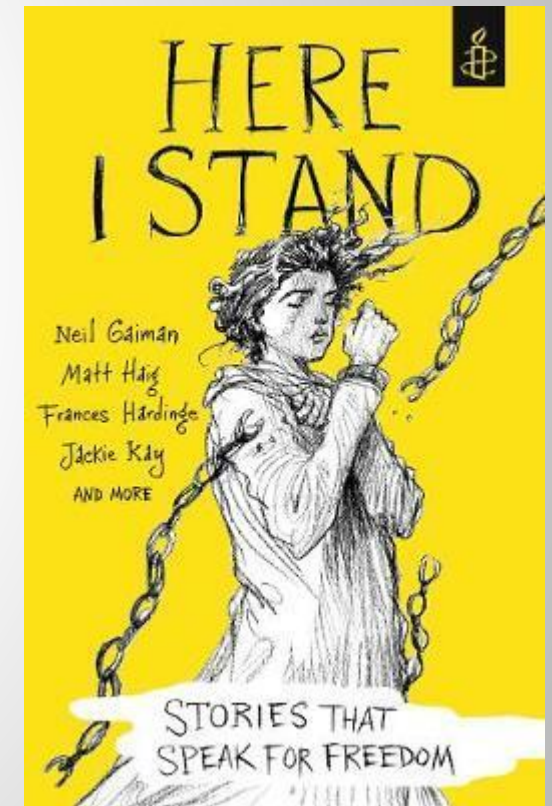
3 Examples from last years cohort:
