Dear Parent / Carer,

Following the decision by the First Minister to delay the return of pupils to school, we met yesterday to discuss the challenges of how best to share feedback with pupils following the Higher and AH assessment window in December given that results and feedback would normally be shared face-to-face in class. Following that discussion, we have made the decision to share this information through formal written reports for all Level 6 and 7 courses. These will be sent home w/c 18th January and will replace the reports that were originally planned for the end of January.

The main purpose of these reports is to share feedback from the assessment window. For all Higher and AH subjects, the report will contain the assessment result with feedback along with a comment on progress and any areas for development moving forward. Most Level 6 Foundation Apprenticeships and NPAs did not have a December assessment, so reports for these subjects will instead focus on whether your child is currently on track to pass along with any relevant feedback. I hope that this approach will ensure that feedback is shared consistently for all pupils sitting Level 6 and 7 courses.

I am aware that some pupils in S5/6 are studying a mixture of Level 4, 5, 6 and 7 courses. Please note that as we have moved the reporting deadline forward, to allow staff adequate time to complete reports, they will only contain information for Level 6 and 7 courses. Written reports for all Level 4 and 5 courses will be shared at a later date.
