About the Walk

The walk will begin before 10am when pupils will be bused to the start of the walk near Auchenblae. They will walk for a distance of approximately 15 kilometres during the day, through Drumtochty Forest and be collected by bus to return to school.

Each pupil should bring:

- a water bottle and packed lunch
- a waterproof jacket and trousers
- a rucksack or shoulder bag to carry lunch, etc.
- insect repellent
- comfortable sturdy footwear
- non-school uniform
- optional fancy dress for pupils in S6 only

Staff will be supervising the route either by walking with pupils or at the checkpoints.

Our school code of conduct of: **Be Considerate, Be Responsible and Be Safe** will apply at all times during the walk.
