Activities Days will take place on Wednesday 29th, Thursday 30th and Friday 31st May 2024 for all S1 – S3 pupils. This booklet contains a selection of non-residential activities as well as larger scale residential activities.

Staff have devoted a large amount of time and effort to ensure that the activities contained in this booklet offer the best value for money for your child and that they have the best experience.

These activity days provide your child with opportunities to:

- Engage in activities outwith the normal classroom situation.
- Try something new.
- Make new friends with pupils from other year groups.
- Contribute to a positive whole school ethos.

Some activities are more expensive than others. Thus, it is anticipated that choices can be made as soon as possible in order to spread any payments necessary and keep them to a minimum. All prices included are subject to change and are to give an indication of the price of each activity at this stage. Once we know the number of pupils that are interested in each activity we will be able to confirm the exact price. A deposit payment for residential trips will be required shortly. Trip leaders will be touch as soon as places are confirmed.
