We demonstrate and allow S1s- S3s to explore and develop their skills in Art from using art supplies they may not get to use in normal art class. For example, we used the Clay and clay tools to make and paint bespoke pumpkins for Halloween. We also did Autumn Leaf printing using the lino print rollers and ink to create Autumn leaf prints. Free drawing and painting using a variety of different mediums such as Charcoal, Coloured Pencils, Water colours, Pastels to explore their creativeness.
